A FLIP THROUGH ITS GOLDEN PAGES

Jauhati University, the oldest and largest University in the North East India, was established in the year 1948. The university was established by an act of the State Legislature: the Gauhati University Act 1947 (Assam Act, XVI of 1947) of the Government of Assam in 1948. It is the product of the collective dreams of visionaries like Gopinath Bardoloi, Krishna Kanta Handique who very early visualized the importance of institutes of higher education in the region. It was the untiring efforts of Fakaruddin Ali Ahmed, Madhab Chandra Bezbaruah, Dr. Bhubaneswar Barua and others that contributed to the establishment of Gauhati University.

The University started functioning from the city centre and was shifted to the present campus in 1955-56. It had 16 affiliated colleges and eight Post Graduate Departments at the time of establishment. At present there are 359 affiliated colleges offering undergraduate and post graduate courses in total of 9 Faculties - Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Medical, Engineering, Fine Arts, Management and Technology. The University has forty-one Post Graduate Departments, an Institute for Distance and Open Learning (IDOL) and a constituent Law College in the main campus.

The University campus is situated at the western fringe of Guwahati, about 15 kilometres from the city centre, and with the mighty Brahmaputra to the North. It has a sprawling scenic and serene campus and is entirely self-contained, with markets, hospital, Bank, Post office, sports facilities etc. The University has impressive academic infrastructure such as well-equipped laboratories, central and departmental libraries and computer facilities. The K.K. Handiqui Central library has been recognized as a manuscript resource and a conservation centre by the Government of India. The University has capacity building centres such as the Career Counseling and Guidance Centre, the Pre-Examination Training Centre and the Women's Study and Research Centre that contribute in the overall development of the students.

The University has introduced a choice-based credit system of education, a student-friendly system where students would get the opportunity of opting for courses according to their interests and needs. The system gives the students a competitive edge in the National and Global Markets. A ten-point grading scale is in place to standardize the academic system with respect to international benchmarks.



APPLICATION FORM FOR ADMISSION

Online application form will be live at admission portal of Gauhati University from 9^{th} June to 23^{rd} June, 2018. The whole admission process will be fully online, including payment of application, Entrance and admission fee.

ELIGIBILITY

- a) BA/BSc /B Com. (in 10+2+3 pattern) with major / honours courses in the concerned subject or BA/BSc /B Com. (in 10+2+3 pattern) with a general pass course with at least 45% marks in the concerned subject as well as in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.
 [45% marks is to be calculated on the basis of marks obtained in Part I and Part II of the (2+1) pattern and part I, part II and Part III of the (1+1+1) pattern are eligible to seek admission to the University through the entrance test. However, certain specific eligibility criteria have been fixed by the concerned departments, will be applicable especially for the interdisciplinary subjects.
- b) Entrance test will be held for all students and all programs of study for admission, irrespective of any university they belong to
- c) Merit list to be prepared for admission, 60% weightage will be on UG marks/qualifying examination marks while 40% weightage will be on the marks obtained in the entrance test for GU students applying to traditional courses.
- d) The selection of students for admission into interdisciplinary programs of study will be purely on the basis of entrance test only. This also applies to other University students applying to any Course.
- e) The entrance test will be of 100 marks of two hours duration, if otherwise not specified. The proportion of descriptive questions and MCOs may vary with respect to different subjects.
- f) An applicant who have completed a Postgraduate Course from GU on an earlier occasion or got admitted into a Postgraduate Course of GU, whether completed or not, will be considered for fresh admission irrespective of whatever quota he / she claims, if any, only when all fresh candidates including those from Wait List and all statutory quotas, including other quota like EC, NCC, Fringe Village etc. are admitted and seats remain vacant. Alternatively, he/she is not entitled to admission until the fresh applicants (first timers) are completely admitted subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria. However, these rules may be relaxed in case of professional courses coming under the purview of regulatory bodies like AICTE, NCTE, BCI, (courses like MBA, MTech, LLM, etc.).

OTHER RESERVATIONS

- a)3% of the total seats for each faculty (Arts, science and commerce) will be kept reserved for differently abled students.
- b) For the sons and daughters of permanent GU employees –one seat (for departments with intake capacity 40 or less) two seat (for departments with intake capacity 40 or more) will be reserved in each department provided such candidate fulfills the eligibility criteria.
- c)Total (10) seats are kept reserved for the students under fringe villages, viz, Garigaon, Sadilapur, Sundarbari and Katiadolong whose parents are permanent residents in the above village(s) since 1950.
- d) Five seats are reserved for the sons and daughters of permanent GU Ex-employees.
- e)Seats reserved for the sons and daughters of ex-defense personnel as per E.C resolution.
- f) A total of 5 seats will be reserved for students under NCC and NSS quota exclusively by segregating these from the category of E.C quota.
- g)Those seeking admission under any reservations/quota (viz. Differently abled/disabled, sons and daughters of permanent GU employees in service, fringe village and extra-curricular & Co-curricular activities, etc.), additional prescribed forms are to be submitted separately in the concerned departments, which can be downloaded from the admissions portal.
- h) 20% of the reserved seats for other University students are to be filled up as per merit list for such students subject to fulfilment of eligibility.

i) A few seats may be offered for admission to MA/MSc. /M. Com courses to students who have shown extraordinary proficiency in Extra- curricular activities in the last three years preceding graduation. Events of sports and other EC activities will be those incorporated in the inter University sports/Cultural /Literary Competition. Any sports event organized by an association must be recognized by and

affiliated to the national body for that sport/event and by Indian Olympic Association.

j) List of selected candidates after processing and recommended by admission committee will be

CRITERIA FOR RESERVATION UNDER EXTRA-CURRICULAR & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Reservation under Extra-Curricular & Co- Curricular Activities:

A few seats may be offered for admission to M.A./M.Sc./M.Com etc Courses to students who have shown extraordinary proficiency in Extra-Curricular activities in the last three years preceding graduation.

Events of sports and other E.C. activities will be those incorporated in the Inter University Sports/Cultural/Literary Competition. Any sport/event organised by an association must be recognised by and affiliated to the national body for that sport/event and by Indian Olympic Association. Preference will be given to candidates in the following order:

- 1. Those who represented the country in International events.
- 2. Those who won Prizes at recognised National level events.
- 3. Those who won Prizes in the Inter-University sports/Cultural/Literary events.
- 4. Those who represented Gauhati University in the Inter-University Sports/ Cultural/Literary meet or the State at National events.
- 5. Those who won Prizes in the Inter-College Youth Festival, G.U. and Inter-College Sports Meet, under G.U. Sports Board.
- 6. Those who won Prizes at recognised State level competitions.
- 7. Students who were awarded fellowships/ scholarships by Central Ministry of Culture, Sports, and Youth Welfare for excellence in art, culture & sports etc.

CRITERIA FOR RESERVATION UNDER NCC AND NSS QUOTA

- 1. Those who have obtained NCC 'C' Certificate or participated in the Republic Day Parade under NCC.
- 2. Those who have obtained NCC'B' Certificates or participated in the Republic Day Parade under NCC. (This is applicable only for the students applying for admission into integrated courses).
- 3. Those who represented the University in NSS Camp at National Level. These certificates need to be obtained in the last three years proceeding.






ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Gauhati University has separate guidelines regarding admission of International Students to Graduate and Masters Programs. Academic qualifications from Universities or Boards of Higher Education, recognized as equivalent by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) shall be the sole criterion for admission under these regulations. These admissions into the various academic programs/courses in the University Departments/Centres for the International/NRI students. By 'International student' is meant one who has valid passport of the home country at the time of application. Students from the negative list of countries of MHRD, Govt. of India will not be admitted. International Students can seek admission to various Graduate and Masters Programs under the following categories:

- Self-financing students (Full program)
- Cultural Exchange Fellowship Programmes (Govt. of India): International students with ICSSR fellowship (Government of India) desirous of admission under this Fellowship Programme are required to apply through the Indian High Commission/ Embassy as the case may be, in their respective countries. Such students need to send the application to ICSSR, Government of India and then ICSSR will forward the application/s to various Universities/Institutes in India as the case may be for consideration. In case the applicant is found suitable for admission, admission offer letter will be sent to him/her through Indian Council for Cultural Relations, New Delhi.
- Visiting Students under Memorandum of Understanding (MoU): Admission of International students/NRI Students under MoUs will be made in accordance with the terms and conditions spelt out in the MoUs agreed to between Gauhati University and the Country/University/Institution concerned. Note: The list of the institutions with whom Gauhati University has entered into MoUs is available at www.gauhati.ac.in

ANTI-RAGGING

Your wards are in safe hands. In order to make the students feel at home and curb the menace of ragging, the university has a very structured Anti-Ragging Committee and some squads. Each student now MUST file an ONLINE Anti-Ragging Affidavit as per the directive received from the UGC. This process DOES NOT involve any money, NO signature form Notary Public / Oath Commissioner etc, and NO need to scan any documents.

This process involves

- 1. Logon to www.antiragging.in
- 2. Fill in the desired information
- 3. On successful completion, you will receive the Affidavits, both for parents and students through email
- 4. Sign them and submit to respective departments.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

INTERNAL COMPLAINT COMMITTEE

The university aspires to be just and balanced in its approach. Hence there is a Internal complaint committee to address complaints and respond to these at the earliest.



GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

- No student shall be admitted to any programme of studies as aforesaid if he/she is found to have indulged in activities
 detrimental to academic interest.
- 2. No student shall be admitted to more than one course in the same shift.
- 3. A student who is found to violate university rules shall be liable to expulsion.
- 4. If a student's involvement in any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, such a student would be given liberty to explain, and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, that student will be expelled from the university.
- A student who is found to have indulged in consumption of drugs or intoxicating drinks, gambling and other immoral activities shall be liable to expulsion.
- Students admitted to various courses of studies are required to participate in instructions (Lectures, tutorials seminars, laboratory works and other academic activities) as prescribed in the relevant Regulations and shall be expected to participate in the Co-Curricular and Extra Curricular activities organised by department or by the university. They are expected to appear at the examination due at the end of the course of studies. Students who fail to do so without assigning sufficient reasons to the satisfaction of the competent authority shall not be permitted'to continue their studies in the following year.
- Attendance in Classes is compulsory. To be eligible to sit for the Examinations as a regular candidate, the students should have at least 75% of attendance of lectures (separately for the theoretical and practical classes) as prescribed in the concerned Regulations.
- 8. Each Academic session will run as per the Academic Calendar published by the University.
- Fees are to be paid for admission by the candidates, if selected on the date as notified, other-wise seats will be cancelled and filled up by candidates next in the list.
- The admission will be granted in accordance with the provision made in the Ordinance on admission of students to P. G. Courses etc.
- 11. The students shall have to comply with the Regulations for the course, Rules and Orders as may be prescribed by the university authority from time to time.
- 12. The decision of competent/appropriate bodies like the Residence, Health and Discipline Board, the Executive Council on all matters relating to students' indiscipline shall be final and binding.

STEP BY STEP ADMISSION PROCESS

- Students and parents/guardians are advised to visit the WebPages of particular departments they are interested.
- Keep ready all documents and information required to submit the Application Form.
- Follow the instructions step by step and proceed.
- An applicant can apply to one Traditional Course and two Interdisciplinary Courses only. Please check the list of Traditional and Interdisciplinary Courses.
- The Application Form for Admission is editable but once you pay the fee, it will no longer be editable. It is not editable after the closing date as well. No request for any change will be entertained in such case, if any.
- You can submit the form even if your result is not declared; you will be given a few days time from 5th July, 2018 to 12th July, 2018 to feed your marks obtained in the qualifying examination. After this period, the window will be closed.
- The e-mail id and phone number of the students and parents/guardians may be used for further communication.
- Please check the eligibility conditions before submission of the Application. Because, even if you clear the entrance test, your admission is subject to fulfilment of the eligibility criteria of the Course/Subject applied. All original documents will be verified at the time of Admission.
- The provisional list of selected students will be published in the University website only.
- Appearance of your name in the provisional merit list is not a guarantee of your admission. It depends on fulfilment of eligibility conditions and intake of the department for the concerned Course.
- All are advised to keep visiting the website for any update regarding the Admission process from time to time.
- The University is not responsible for any unwanted technical failure which may disturb the admission process from the side of the University or from the end of the student, if any.
