Other Details of GUBEDCET-2019:

- 1. All questions will be of MCQ type with four alternative choices of which only one answer will be the correct option.
- 2. The test Booklet and the OMR will be in English. The test will be OMR based.
- **3.** There will be 4 marks for correct answer and (-1) for wrong answer. No negative marks for unanswered questions.
- 4. Merit list will be prepared only on the basis of marks obtained in GUBEDCET-2019. In case of a tie, i.e. when two or more candidates obtain equal marks, inter-se merit of such candidates shall be decided as follows:
 - i. Resolution by finding the ratio of positive marks and negative marks. Candidate having higher absolute value of the ratio will be given better rank.
 - ii. Resolution by marks obtained in Section-A. Candidate obtaining higher marks will be given better rank.
 - iii. Resolution by marks obtained in Section-B. Candidate obtaining higher marks will be given better rank.
 - iv. Resolution by marks obtained in Section-C. Candidate obtaining higher marks will be given better rank.
 - v. Resolution by marks obtained in Section-D. Candidate obtaining higher marks will be given better rank.
 - vi. Resolution by number of unanswered questions in Section-A. Candidate with less number of unanswered questions will be given better rank.
 - vii. Resolution by number of unanswered questions in Section-B. Candidate with less number of unanswered questions will be given better rank.
 - viii. Resolution by number of unanswered questions in Section-C. Candidate with less number of unanswered questions will be given better rank.
 - ix. Resolution by number of unanswered questions in Section-D. Candidate with less number of unanswered questions will be given better rank.
 - x. If the resolution is not possible after this criterion, candidates with higher age will be given better rank.
- 5. Eligibility criteria will be verified by the respective colleges before admission.
- 6. Reservation and relaxation policy will be as per existing GU rules.
- 7. Application and Entrance Examination Fee: Rs.1000.00 + Bank Transaction Charge.
- 8. Anything not covered by this guideline will be decided by the university authority at appropriate level.
